Route Descriptions

- Direct Routes**
Direct bike routes help make needed connections.
 - On Direct Bike Routes without bike lanes people biking share the space with motor vehicles.
 - On Direct Bike Routes with bike lanes there is a lane just for biking and rolling.
- More Comfortable Routes**
While individual comfort levels will vary, these routes are generally along roads with lower motor vehicle speeds and/or fewer motor vehicles passing.
 - On More Comfortable Bike Routes without bike lanes, people biking share space with motor vehicles.
 - On More Comfortable Bike Routes with bike lanes, there is a lane just for biking and rolling.
 - On More comfortable Routes with neighborhood bikeways, people biking share space with motor vehicles, but bicycle travel is prioritized with pavement marking and signage.
- Multi-Use Trails and Neighborhood Trails**
Are separated from the roadway with curb and/or a grass/landscaped buffer or located away from roads. While individual comfort levels will vary, trails are generally comfortable for most users. Neighborhood trails are narrower than multi-use trails.
- Primitive and Soft Surface**
Not Paved trails are generally used for hiking or mountain biking.

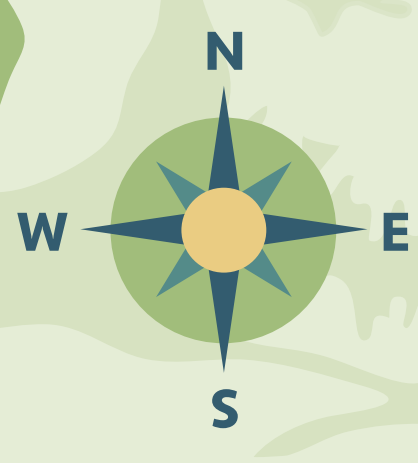
