2 LBS Raw P&D Mexican Shrimp 1/2 Cup Red Onion (sliced paper thin) 4 Bay Leaves 2 TBSP Olive Oil 1/3 Cup White-Wine Vinegar 1 TSP Dill 2 TSP Celery Seed 1 TSP Salt

Boil shrimp 1/2 lb at a time (usually 3-4 min, or until shrimp curl into 'c' shape). Immediately remove & place in ice water. Drain well.

Layer shrimp in a glass bowl with onion slices and bay leaves. Combine vinegar, olive oil, celery seed, salt & dill.

Pour over shrimp. Cover & refrigerate 24 hours. Stir occasionally . Just before serving, stir in a splash of lemon or lime juice.













